Generate Economic and Social Changes in the Cambodian Rural Farmers Families by Improving the Food Market through Agroecology (AE) Transition and Gender Equity in Agriculture.

Levels of Interventions:

- A. One landscape level on 3 sites:
 - Tramkak Union of Agricultural Cooperatives in
 (3 ACs)
 - Battambang Union of Agricultural Cooperatives (10 ACs)
 - 5 ACs in Kampong Thom
- B. One macro level Mutual reinforcement of ALiSEA members

SUPPORTS TO ALISEA NETWORK IN CAMBODIA



- Uni4Coop, in partnership with DPA, provides supports to ALiSEA network in Cambodia through:
 - Building network among ALiSEA members
 - Organizing capacity building sessions to ALISEA members;
 - Managing ALiSEA's local social media platforms to promote visibility of the network and raise public awareness of AE to key stakeholders and the public; and
 - overseeing small-grant schemes to promote agroecology in Cambodia.

FACTS ON ALISEA'S SMALL-GRANT SCHEMES IN CAMBODIA



- ALiSEA's Small-Grant Scheme in Cambodia run from 2022 to 2025.
- Uni4Coop through DPA joined forces to implement the call for proposals in 2022 and 2023.
- Available Fund for Small-Grant Schemes
 - GRET: 300,000 EUR for 5 countries from 2022 2023
 - Uni4Coop: 72,415 EUR for ALiSEA members in Cambodia from 2022 - 2025



FACTS ON ALISEA'S SMALL-GRANT SCHEMES IN CAMBODIA (CONT.)



- Two grants are being awarded to ALISEA members in Cambodia in 2022 – One will be contracted by Uni4Coop and the other by GRET.
- The number of the awarded applicants in 2023 will be based on available funds and the potential of applications.
- From 2024 to 2025, DPA will be the focal organization to organize and oversee the ALISEA small-grant schemes in Cambodia.

SMALL-GRANT TOPICS



A. SMALL-GRANT TOPICS IN 2022

- Assess the impact and effect of public policy supporting agroecology and food systems.
- 2. Test and support agroecological innovations.
- 3. Evaluation of the performances and impacts of agricultural and food system.

B. SMALL-GRANT TOPICS FROM 2023 ONWARD

The topics will be based on results from the national Theory of Change (ToC) workshop in October 2022 and the ALiSEA's Annual General Assembly.
