# Family farmers around the world

Account for more than 90% of the farms

Occupy around 70–80% of farmland

Produce more than 80% of the world's food in value terms

#### Farms of less that 2 ha:

- account for 84% of all farms
- But operate on only 12% of all agricultural land
- And still produce 36% of the world's food






# Family Farmers in Asia and the Pacific

Asia and Pacific region accounts for 74 per cent of the world's family farmers

Small-scale, family-based food producers account for almost 80 percent of the milk production, and 80-90 percent of aquaculture farms in Asia.







# Small holder farmers in Laos?

- > 77% of family households in Laos are farmers with average size of 5 people
- ➤ 65% of family households have land between 0.5-2.9 ha; and 27% has land more than 3 ha.
- > 95% of family farmers engaged in rice production for household consumption, thus, rice is a very important crop.
- In addition to rice production, the farmers produce other cash crops such as coffee, tea, seasonal vegetables, maize, cassava, sugarcane and livestock for domestic and regional markets.
- Family farming is strong in Lao PDR, producing over 80% of all food consumed in the country.






Produce less rice but rather produce long term cash crops.
