1. Communication and Networking



5. Citizens' awareness raising regarding public policies




- National Foresight & Theory of Change to build common and desired vision on Agroecology and to guide interventions

- Co-developed action plans with members and Board Members by identification of areas where ALiSEA is the most suitable and where it should focus its efforts







