



YOUTH EMPLOYMENT CONTEXT IN CAMBODIA

- Youth under the age of 30 make up about 65% of 16.6 millons Cambodia's population, according to UNDP.
- Agriculture accounts for 22 percent of Cambodia's GDP, and employs about 3 million people.
- more than two thirds of young people in Cambodia are relying on agriculture for their livelihoods (OECD, 2018)
- Over 1.3 million Cambodians are working abroad According to a spokesman for the Ministry of Labour and Vocational Training (MLVT)

ISSUE FACING BY RURAL YOUTH IN AGRICULTURE

- Youth is generally seen as having lost interest in farming, considering as hard work, high risk and low income
- Lack of source funding to start farming activity
- Limited accessing to decent agricultural and marketing training, referred to short course practical training
- Government does not yet have specific policies to support rural young farmers
- Difficult accessing to land
- Climate change impacts

FAEC

FARMER ORGANISATION FOR ASIA (FO4A) PROGRAM



- Funded by: EU-IFAD through AgriCord
- Implemented by: AFDI-FAEC
- Target areas: 10 agricultural cooperatives in Svay rieng, Kampong Speu, Kampong Thom and Battamban provinces.
- Target beneficiaries: 120 young farmer (age 18-40), including 50% women and 10% vulnerable people.

AGRICULTURAL CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT



- Agricultural technique training (vegetables, native chicken raising, natural compost)
- Combination of theory and practical skills
- Digital agriculture (access to data, technical and market information, application ect.)
- Post-training support to farmer through direct counseling and telegram groups exchange.

- Exchange visit between farmer and farmer at international (France, Laos)



PRODUCTS MARKET LINKAGE

- Promote direct selling at farm
- Supply to local market and distributor
- Supply to organic stores in city



YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

- Leadership and Management training,
 and integrate them into cooperative
 leader's role.
- Support youth group monthly meeting to share information and collect issues.
- Support youth and cooperative representatives to participate quarterly meeting with commune to raise awareness, concerns and suggestion.
- Support youth and cooperative to attend to national and regional events.
