

6. Developing a research agenda for agroecology transition

Explanation

- Agroecology integrates modern science with traditional knowledge. Research plays a vital role in strengthening the credibility of practices developed by local communities and Indigenous Peoples. Research also helps actors develop a systemic and forward-looking vision at farm, landscape, and food system levels, and builds innovative pathways for transitions
- In turn, to transform research findings into widespread innovations and changes, renewed collaboration models between research systems and stakeholders – especially farmers and extension services – are essential
- The private sector also plays a key, and often overlooked, role in research

- 6.5 Address food system scale agroecology research agenda (subnational, national and global)






